Course Summary: This course is designed for clinicians seeking to improve their skills in order to confidently restore composite cases, from simple to complex.

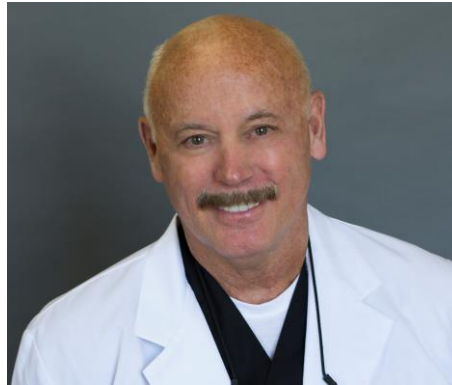
Course Objectives: Techniques taught in the course will enable the participants to create life-like esthetically pleasing restorations. Polishing and finishing techniques will be reviewed in detail and a step-by-step procedural approach to solving daily anterior challenges will be presented

- Understanding of layering techniques required to produce natural esthetics;
- Exploring various finishing and polishing techniques for creating natural esthetics;
- Understanding the four visual dimensions of restoration esthetics; color, hue, chroma, and translucency;
- Understanding how to use a composite system properly, employing different opacities and translucencies.

Frank Milnar, DDS, AACD

Frank J. Milnar DDS, AACD is a graduate from the University of Minnesota, School of Dentistry in 1976. He is an Accredited member of the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry and a Board Examiner for its Accreditation process. He has published numerous articles about the direct placement of composites, shade selection and porcelain materials and is on editorial review boards for dental journals.. Dr. Milnar is co-founder of the Minnesota Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry and has lectured extensively within the US Armed Forces as well as internationally on the subject of direct composite restorations, shade selection and porcelain materials. He has been voted "Top Dentist" and voted into the "Top Dentist Hall of Fame" for the last five years by his peers in the Minneapolis/St. Paul Magazine. He has been voted by Dentistry Today as one of the top 100 dentists contributing to dental education. Most recently, Dr. Milnar was nominated to the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry Continuing Education Advisory Board and is a Visiting Faculty Member for the BIOCLEAR Learning Center.
